HURRICANE IRENE

Mr. Stephens called the Special Meeting (notice provided by telephone) to order for declaration of a state and local emergency authorizing evacuation implementations and emergency measures due to Hurricane Irene.

Karen Windon, Public Safety Director, submitted maps showing the track of the storm and gave a brief update on the hurricane and the action taken in preparedness. She expressed concern regarding the amount of rain (10 to 20 inches) and flooding that is expected. She stated there may be a possible mandatory evacuation and requested adoption of:

R-99-258 A RESOLUTION OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING EVACUATION IMPLEMENTATION AND OTHER EMERGENCY MEASURES.

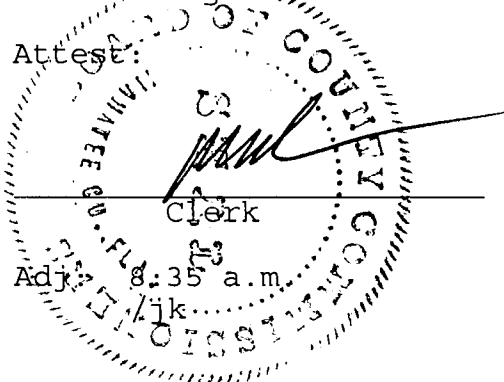
Motion was made by Mrs. Glass, seconded by Mr. Bruce and carried 4 to 0, to adopt R-99-258. RECORD 847-601
