Motion was made by Mrs. Glass, seconded by Mr. Bruce and carried 4 to 0, to adopt R-00-1000. RECORD S47-2003


Discussion: Voluntary evacuation areas; emergency generator; activate emergency plans; allow purchase of materials; etc.
