1. CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICER'S BUDGETS

Claudia Campos, Interim Chief Financial Officer, used a slide presentation to review the Constitutional Officer's budgets, noted the Sheriff's Budget will be presented on July 30, reviewed the submitted budgets for the Clerk of the Circuit Court, Supervisor of Elections, Tax Collector, Property Appraiser, Court Administration, Guardian Ad Litem, Public Defender, and State Attorney, including expenditures, the budgets for the Constitutional Officers went down, and reviewed assumptions regarding decreases and increases.

Discussion ensued regarding capital expenditures, State mandated costs, operating costs for buildings fall under County expenditures, Guardian Ad Litem reduction in staff salary, personnel costs can cause a minor increase, and usually the Constitutional Officer's present their budgets and provide updates on their offices.
