

ORDINANCE NO. 78-3

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT REGARDING SURPLUS COUNTY AD VALOREM TAXATION FUNDS; PROVIDING THAT THE TAX COLLECTOR OF MANATEE COUNTY DEPOSIT CERTAIN COUNTY AD VALOREM TAXATION FUNDS IN SAVINGS ACCOUNTS OF LOCAL DEPOSITORYES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of Manatee County and will not unduly slow the normal distribution of surplus ad valorem taxation funds to have said funds invested in the savings accounts of local depositories qualified according to Chapter 136, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 659, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 77-394, Laws of Florida, provides that counties shall deposit ad valorem taxation funds while surplus or pending distribution in the Local Government Surplus Funds Trust Fund unless another procedure has been prescribed by law or ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The Tax Collector of Manatee County is authorized to invest surplus ad valorem taxation funds in savings accounts in depositories qualified according to Chapter 136, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 659, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with that Office.
