

ORDINANCE NO. 78-4

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT REGARDING THE MILEAGE PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; REPEALING SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 67-778 OF THE SPECIAL ACTS OF FLORIDA; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 74-12 OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Chapter 67-778 of the Special Acts of Florida provided for the payment of mileage to members of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, a local law relating only to the unincorporated area of Manatee County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 74-12 of Manatee County, Florida, passed and adopted November 19, 1974, amended said Section 1 of Chapter 67-778 of the Special Acts of Florida, and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 112.061 of the Florida Statutes and other general provisions of law adequately provide authorization for the payment of mileage and other traveling expenses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 67-778 of the Special Acts of Florida, providing for the payment of mileage under certain circumstances to members of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, be and the same is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 74-12 of Manatee County, Florida, passed and adopted November 19, 1974 filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida on November 27, 1974, and entitled An Ordinance Of Manatee County, Florida, Providing For An Increase In Mileage Rate Paid To County Officers And Employees To 14 Cents Per Mile; Amending The Provisions Of Section 1, Chapter 67-778, Special Laws Of Florida 1967 Accordingly; Providing An Effective Date, be and the same is hereby repealed in its entirety.
