

ORDINANCE NO. 78-7

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT REGARDING ESTABLISHING THE HOURS FOR ALLOWING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC AND INTOXICATING BEVERAGES WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; ESTABLISHING THE HOURS FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC AND INTOXICATING BEVERAGES WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS USED HEREIN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 562.14 of the Florida Statutes previously authorized the Board of County Commissioners of any county in the State of Florida, by resolution, to independently regulate the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages within the territory of such county not included within any municipality of said county, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, by resolution, under the provisions of Section 562.14 of the Florida Statutes, did regulate the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages within the territory of the County, not included within any municipality, and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 562.14 of the Florida Statutes were amended to authorize the County to provide by Ordinance for hours during which alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed, served, or permitted to be served or consumed in any place within the unincorporated area of a county holding a license under the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the State of Florida.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. No alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed, served or permitted to be served or consumed in any place within the unincorporated areas of Manatee County, Florida, holding a license under the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco between the hours of 2:30 a.m., and 7:00 a.m., of the same day.

Section 2. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be guilty a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in Section 775.082 or Section 775.083 of the Florida Statutes.

Section 3. The definition of the term "alcoholic beverages" as used herein shall be as defined by the general laws of the State of Florida.




