

ORDINANCE NO. 79-14

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA,
REGULATING AND PROHIBITING THE STOPPING,
STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES
WITHIN THE AIRPORT FACILITIES AND LANDS
OF THE SARASOTA-MANATEE AIRPORT AUTHORITY;
PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING OF TEMPORARY
EXCEPTION; PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OR
DISPLAY OF APPROPRIATE NO PARKING OR NO
STOPPING SIGNS; PROHIBITING THE DIS-
OBEDIENCE OF REASONABLE AND LAWFUL ORDERS
OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS; PROVIDING A
PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF
CHAPTER 67-2053, LAWS OF FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Chapter 67-2053, Laws of Florida, authorizes
the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority, by resolution, to
request the County of Manatee, Florida, to enact and adopt
ordinances regarding the operation, guidance, storing,
parking, loading, unloading and conduct of all motor
vehicles of any kind within the various airport facilities
and lands of the Airport Authority; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority has
requested by that certain resolution adopted by said
Authority on September 18, 1979, that the County of Manatee,
Florida, enact such ordinances as may be necessary in the
furtherance of the public health, safety, welfare and
interest, to regulate the operation of motor vehicles of
all kinds, institute traffic and parking control plans,
provide means of enforcement of such ordinances and provide
penalties for violation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County
Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. Except as otherwise provided herein, it shall be unlawful for any person to stop, stand or park a motor vehicle of any kind upon any portion of the airport facilities and lands encompassing the territory comprising the area of control and regulation by the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority.

Section 2. It shall not be a violation of this Ordinance to allow the temporary stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles within certain designated and identified areas comprising the lands of the Airport Authority which have been designated by the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority to temporarily allow such stopping, standing or parking. The excepted areas shall be conspicuously marked and identified by appropriate signs authorizing or allowing the temporary stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles for a specific period of time and within specific hours of the day and days of the week.

Section 3. The Airport Manager is authorized to erect appropriate NO PARKING and/or NO STOPPING signs or other necessary traffic signs in conspicuous locations on the Airport facilities and lands within the area of control and regulation of the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority.


Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to refuse to obey the reasonable and lawful order of any law enforcement officer given while in the performance of his duties in directing, regulating and controlling the movement of motor vehicles and traffic within the Airport facilities and lands of the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority.

Section 5. Any person violating the terms, provisions or Sections of this Ordinance shall be penalized as provided for by the general laws of the State of Florida.


Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of the official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
