AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT; PROHIBITING THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON CERTAIN COUNTY MAINTAINED STREET (9TH STREET EAST) IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING A CIVIL PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 125.01 of the Florida Statutes, the County of Manatee, Florida, by and through its Board of County. Commissioners is authorized to provide and regulate roads, parking facilities and develop and enforce plans for control of traffic and parking within said County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 316 of the Florida Statutes, the County of Manatee, Florida, retains jurisdiction over the public streets, highway, roadways and parking areas located within the unincorporated areas of said County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, in order to promote the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of said County, has determined that it is in the best interests of said citizens to regulate and prohibit the parking, standing or stopping of motor vehicles on the hereinafter designated public streets, highways or roadways within said County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, stand or park a motor vehicle upon any portion of the paved travel-way of the right-of-way of 9th Street East from the intersection of Magellan Drive north 100 feet, all located within the unincorportated area of Manatee County, Florida.

Section 2. The Manatee County Department of Transporation (Traffic Engineering Section) shall erect appropriate "No Parking" signs in conspicuous locations within the paved travelway of the right-of-way of the streets designated in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating the terms of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have committed a traffic infraction and shall be penalized as provided by ordinance of the County of Manatee, Florida.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, then such judgement shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify any remaining portions of this Ordinance, but the effect thereof shall be confined to the section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause, sentence or provision involved in the judgement so rendered.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgement from the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
