WHEREAS, Manatee County, Florida, intends to enact an Adult

3. Entertainment Ordinance and Code; and

WHEREAS, the Adult Entertainment Ordinance and Code will

regulate adult entertainment establishments, including adult dancing establishments; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 79-1 indirectly controls and regulates adult dancing establishments; and

WHEREAS, though portions of the Adult Entertainment Ordinance and Code appear to cover similar subjects, some conflict could arise with respect to interpretation; and

WHEREAS, the Adult Entertainment Ordinance and Code is comprehensive and designed to supersede any prior similar or inconsistent or similar ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Repeal. Ordinance 79-1 adopted January 30, 1979 concerning the prohibition of exhibiting certain anatomical parts in an establishment at which alcoholic and intoxicating beverages are offered for sale and consumed on the premises is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgement from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.


