AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA
AMENDING MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-04
TO PROHIBIT THE STOPPING, STANDING OR
PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON 57TH AVENUE
WEST (CR 48) FROM 21ST STREET WEST TO
BRIDGE OVER CEDAR HAMMOCK; 65TH AVENUE
DRIVE WEST FROM 9TH STREET WEST TO 12TH
STREET WEST; 52ND AVENUE TERRACE WEST
FROM 26TH STREET WEST TO 30TH STREET
WEST; 61ST STREET WEST (PALM VIEW ROAD)
875' EAST OF US 19 (SR 55) EAST 590'
AROUND CURVE; 16TH STREET WEST FROM
53RD AVENUE WEST TO 55TH AVENUE WEST;
34TH STREET WEST FROM CORTEZ ROAD
(SR 684) TO MIAMI PLACE, COUNTY
MAINTAINED STREETS IN THE UNINCOR-
PORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 316 of the Florida
Statutes, the County of Manatee, Florida, retains jurisdiction
over the public streets, highways, roadways and parking areas
located within the unincorporated areas of said county; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County
Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-04, Section 1 be amended to
add the following no parking zones:

57th Avenue West (CR 48) from 21st Street West
to bridge over Cedar Hammock.

65th Avenue Drive West from 9th Street West to
12th Street West.

52nd Avenue Terrace West from 26th Street West
to 30th Street West.

61st Street West (Palm View Road) 875' east of
US 19 (SR 55) east 590' around curve.


16th Street West from 53rd Avenue West to 55th
Avenue West.

34th Street West from Cortez Road (SR 684) to
Miami Place.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective
immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgment from
the office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida,
that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
