61st Street West (Palm View Road) 875' east of US 19 (SR 55) east 590' around curve.

16th Street West from 53rd Avenue West to 55th Avenue West.

34th Street West from Cortez Road (SR 684) to Miami Place.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
