AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 80-3 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCES 82-08, 82-26, 83-18, 83-23, 83-34, AND 84-17; PROVIDING A TOURIST DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR MANATEE COUNTY AND PROVIDING FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS COLLECTED BY THE TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX FOR DIRECT ADVERTISING, ADMINISTRATION AND SUPPLIES, AND FOR CIVIC CENTER, TOURIST INFORMATION CENTER; OTHER CIVIC ENTERPRISES COMPRISED TOTALLY OF McKECHNIE FIELD BASEBALL FIELD, BRADENTON MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM, AND GREEN BRIDGE FISHING PIER MAINTENANCE; AND BEACH MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR A CONTINGENCY FUND AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 2, 1980, the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners passed and duly adopted Manatee County Ordinance 80-3 providing, inter alia, for the levy of a local option tourist development tax and the adoption of a Tourist Development Plan (TDP); and

WHEREAS, the Tourist Development Council (TDC), established by Section 4 of Manatee County Ordinance 80-3, has, pursuant to the authority granted to it by subsection 4(F) of Ordinance 80-3, made certain recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners concerning the effective operation of the projects or uses set out in Manatee County's TDP, as adopted by Section 3 of Ordinance 80-3; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Manatee County Ordinance 80-3 established the original Tourist Development Plan and Manatee County Ordinances 82-08, 82-26, 83-18, 83-23, 83-34, and 84-17 have extended and amended the Tourist Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Ordinance 80-3 provides that the Tourist Development Plan shall not be substantially amended except by an ordinance of Manatee County enacted by an affirmative vote of a majority plus one additional member of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1:

Section 3 of Ordinance 80-3 shall be deleted and a new Section 3 shall read as follows:

Section 3.

The tax revenues and funds received by Manatee County pursuant to this Ordinance shall be expended according to the County's Tourist Development Plan, which is hereby adopted and set forth as follows:

A. It is estimated that Tourist Development tax revenues will be between \$500,000 and \$600,000 per year.

B. The allocation, in order of priority, of the tourist development tax revenue (less the three percent (3%) for administrative or state costs for collection and administration, as authorized by Section 125.0104, Florida Statutes, as amended) for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 1985, and for each of the four succeeding fiscal years, shall be authorized as follows:

I. DIRECT ADVERTISING: At least 50%, but no more than 70% of the tourist development tax revenues in any fiscal year shall be allocated to Direct Advertising which shall be used for print and broadcast advertising, direct mail, publicity, special promotions and administration and supplies.

II. CIVIC CENTER: At least 20%, but no more than 30% of the tourist development tax revenues in any fiscal year shall be used for promotion, administration and operation expenses of the Manatee County Civic Center.

1 III. TOURIST INFORMATION CENTER. At least
2 10%, but no more than 20% of the tourist devel-
3 opment tax revenues in any fiscal year shall
4 be used for construction, maintenance, equip-
5 ment and operation expenses of the Manatee
6 County Tourist Information Center.

7 IV. OTHER CIVIC ENTERPRISES COMPRISED
8 TOTALLY OF MCKECHNIE FIELD BASEBALL FIELD,
9 BRADENTON MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM, AND GREEN
10 BRIDGE FISHING PIER: The expenditure of
11 \$4,000 of 1984-1985 revenues for the Braden-
12 ton Municipal Auditorium is hereby authorized.
13 The expenditure of no more than 10% of the
14 tourist development tax revenues in any
15 subsequent fiscal year may be allocated for
16 maintenance, promotion and/or operation of
17 any one or a combination of the following:
18 McKechnie Field Baseball Field, Bradenton
19 Municipal Auditorium and Green Bridge
20 Fishing Pier.

21 V. BEACH MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT. No
22 more than 10% of the Tourist Development Tax
23 Revenues in any fiscal year may be used for beach
24 improvement, maintenance, renourishment, restora-
25 tion and/or erosion control.

26 VI. CONTINGENCY. At least 4%, but no
27 more than 10% of the tourist development tax
28 revenues in any fiscal year shall be
29 designated as Contingency and may be dis-
30 bursed only for one of the purposes
31 authorized under this section, by resolution
32 of the Board of County Commissioners adopted
33 at any time during the fiscal year.

1 C. The specific allocation of funds within
2 the authorized ranges established by this ordi-
3 nance shall be made by resolution of the Board of
4 County Commissioners of Manatee County prior to
5 the commencement of each fiscal year to which this
6 ordinance applies.

7 Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective
8 upon receipt of the official acknowledgment from the Office
9 of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that
10 this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
