ORDINANCE 85-30

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 85-11; PROVIDING FOR A DEFINITION OF "EXTRAORDINARY SERVICES;" PROVIDING FOR CLARIFICATION OF SECTION 40 WHICH RELATES TO EXTRAORDINARY SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, adopted Ordinance 85-11, which provided for a mandatory collection and disposal of solid waste within the unincorporated areas of Manatee County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, mandatory collection and disposal of solid waste within the unincorporated areas of Manatee County, Florida, will become effective October 1, 1985; and

WHEREAS, in preparation of mandatory collection and disposal of solid waste, the County has awarded franchises to various qualified petitioners; and

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that there is a variance between Ordinance 85-11 and the various franchise agreements with respect to the procedure for arranging the collection and disposal of extraordinary solid waste services; and

WHEREAS, since the procedure expressed in the various franchise agreements reflects the most effective method for handling the arrangement process, it is therefore necessary to amend Ordinance 85-11 accordingly to reflect the procedure expressed in the various franchise agreements; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to define the term "extraordinary services" that is referred to in Ordinance 85-11.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 85-11, Section 2 is amended to reflect the following -- After the definition of "Director," a new definition "Extraordinary services" will be added and will read as follows:

"Section 2. Definitions.

"Extraordinary Services shall mean residential solid waste collection services that require additional time,

effort, and expense because the solid waste is not placed in authorized receptacles, or is not bundled properly as set forth in this Ordinance. Extraordinary services shall also mean residential solid waste collection services which are not collected at curbside. Necessarily, extraordinary services will include, but not be limited to, back-door collection, side-door collection, and the removal of large quantities of loose Garden Trash."

Section 2. Ordinance 85-11, Section 40 is amended in part to read as follows:

"Section 40. Extraordinary Services.

Extraordinary services such as back-door collection and the removal of large quantities of loose Garden Trash is not a part of the Residential Collection Services Charge. Such services must be arranged for with the County on an individual basis and the excess charge will be billed by the Department. Loose Garden Trash will be billed at the Commercial Bulk Collection Service rate; however, the customer is entitled to an estimate prior to such service."


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgement from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
