

ORDINANCE NO. 85-31

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-04; AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCES 84-15 AND 84-24, TO PROHIBIT THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON 65TH STREET EAST (MANATEE PALMS DRIVE) FROM THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ROAD 64 TO THE INTERSECTION OF ALPINE LANE; TALLEVAST ROAD FROM THE INTERSECTION OF US 301 TO THE INTERSECTION OF 17TH STREET EAST; YORK DRIVE (15TH STREET WEST) FROM THE INTERSECTION OF CORTEZ ROAD SOUTH TO THE DEAD END; 17TH STREET EAST (MEMPHIS ROAD) FROM THE INTERSECTION OF 47TH AVENUE DRIVE WEST TO DEAD END; 51ST AVENUE EAST FROM THE INTERSECTION OF 17TH STREET EAST TO THE INTERSECTION OF US 301, COUNTY MAINTAINED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 316 of the Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, retains jurisdiction over the public streets, highways, roadways and parking areas located within the unincorporated areas of said County; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-04, Section 1, be amended to add the following no parking zones:

1. 65th Street East (Manatee Palms Drive) from the intersection of State Road 64 to the intersection of Alpine Lane.
2. Tallevast Road from the intersection of US 301 to the intersection of 17th Street East.
3. York Drive (15th Street West) from the intersection of Cortez Road south to the dead end.
4. 17th Street East (Memphis Road) from the intersection of 47th Avenue Drive East to dead end.
5. 51st Avenue East from the intersection of 17th Street East to the intersection of US 301.




