

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-06; TO REGULATE THE TRAVEL ON CERTAIN THROUGH TRAFFIC ON 3RD AVENUE WEST FROM 59TH STREET WEST TO 63RD STREET WEST; 5TH STREET WEST FROM 60TH AVENUE TERRACE WEST TO 63RD AVENUE WEST, COUNTY MAINTAINED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316.008 (1)(n), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida is empowered to regulate or prohibit the use of heavily traveled streets by any class or kind of traffic found to be incompatible with the normal and safe movement of traffic;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-06, Section 1 be amended to add the following no through truck zone:

3rd Avenue West from 59th Street West to 63rd Street West
5th Street West from 60th Avenue Terrace West to 63rd Avenue West

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgement from the office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.






