WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316.189(2), Florida

Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, may set maximum and minimum speed limit in zones after an investigation and determination that such limits are reasonable and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-05, Section 1, be amended to add the following speed limit zones:

- 57th Avenue (CR 48) from US 41 (SR 45, 14th Street West) to 15th Street East (SR 683) 40 MPH
- Chapman Road from US 41 to Bud Rhoden Road 35 MPH
- 75th Avenue East from 39th Street East to Linden Lane 25 MPH


