AMENDING ORDINANCE 86-14; ADDING
SECTION 8 TO PART VI THEREOF; PROVIDING
THAT THE ORDINANCE IS NOT TO BE
CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT IMPORTATION,
PURCHASE, SALE OR USE OF FIREWORKS
USED SOLELY IN FRIGHTENING BIRDS FROM
AGRICULTURAL WORKS AND FISH HATCHERIES
OR TO PROHIBIT ANY SALE OR USE OF
FIREWORKS AUTHORIZED BY STATE LAW; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners enacted Ordinance 86-14 effective May 15, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Section 791.07, Florida Statutes, provides that nothing in Chapter 791 shall prohibit importation, purchase, sale, or use of fireworks that are used solely and exclusively in frightening birds from agricultural works and fish hatcheries; and

WHEREAS, it would be appropriate to clarify that Ordinance 86-14 is not intended to conflict with Section 791.07, Florida Statutes, or any other section of Florida Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. Amendment. Ordinance 86-14 is hereby amended by adding Section 8 to Part VI thereof, said Section 8 to read as follows:

8. Uses Authorized by Statute.

Notwithstanding any other portion of this ordinance, nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prohibit the importation, purchase, sale or use of fireworks used or to be used solely and exclusively in frightening birds from agricultural works and fish hatcheries, nor shall this ordinance be construed to prohibit sale or use of fireworks authorized by state law.

2. Effective Date. This amendment shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgment

from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this ordinance has been filed with that office.


