WHEREAS, Section 3 of Manatee County Ordinance 80-3 established the original Tourist Development Plan, and Manatee County Ordinances 82-08, 82-26, 83-18, 83-23, 83-34, 84-17, 85-29 and 86-26, have extended and amended the Tourist Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Ordinance 80-3 provides that the Tourist Development Plan shall not be substantially amended except by an Ordinance of Manatee County enacted by an affirmative vote of a majority plus one (1) additional member of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Council for the Arts has requested funding for specified advertising and promotional campaigns; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Council for the Arts has developed significant cultural events, attracting artists from across the country and throughout the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, in a public hearing based upon all evidence and testimony presented, it was determined that the contribution of funds to support the street fair; concert in the park; art show and performing arts program; the photography show; and to advertise and promote those events, would primarily contribute to the promotion and advertising of tourism in the State of Florida, and nationally and internationally; and

WHEREAS, promotion of the arts and the special events planned by the Council for the Arts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

1. Section 3 b.IV of Ordinance 80-3 shall be amended as follows:

"J" Tourist Development Plan

IV. Other Civic Enterprises:

No more than ten percent (10%) of the Tourist Development Tax revenues in any fiscal year may be used for maintenance, promotion and/or operation of enterprises qualified under Section 125.0104, Florida Statutes, or any other applicable Law, and may include, but not be limited to, McKechnie Field, Bradenton Municipal Auditorium, Green Bridge Fishing Pier, the Historical Park Tourist Information Center, and the funding of advertising and promotional activities sponsored by the Manatee County Council for the Arts.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed effective upon receipt of acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that Office.

PASSED AND DULY ADOPTED by a majority plus one (1) vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, this, the 18th day of November, 1986.


