WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316.008(1)(n), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, is empowered to regulate or prohibit the use of heavily traveled streets by any class or kind of traffic found to be incompatible with the normal and safe movement of traffic;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-06, Section 1, be amended to add the following no through truck zones:

80th Street West from Cortez Road (SR 684) to 43rd Avenue West

81st Street West from Cortez Road (SR 684) to 43rd Avenue West

82nd Street West from Cortez Road (SR 684) to 43rd Avenue West

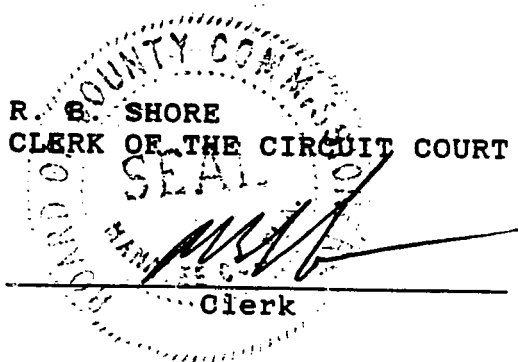
51st Avenue West from 5th Street West to 9th Street West

51st Avenue Drive West from 9th Street West to 14th Street West (US 41)

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgement from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.


