AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY,  
FLORIDA DESIGNATING 5TH STREET  
CIRCLE EAST, A COUNTY MAINTAINED  
ROADWAY LOCATED WITHIN  
UNINCORPORATED MANATEE COUNTY, FOR  
USE BY TRAFFIC MOVING IN ONE  
DIRECTION ONLY; REQUIRING THE  
ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNS;  
PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS AND  
PENALTIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316.008, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida may designate roadways under its jurisdiction for use by traffic moving in one direction only; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the property owners, whose properties abut 5th Street Circle East, are in favor of designating said road as a one-way road.

WHEREAS, Manatee County has determined, as regards 5th Street Circle East, that such a designation is appropriate, reasonable and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the Florida Department of Transportation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. The following roadways are hereby designated for use by traffic moving in one direction only:

- (a) 5th Street Circle East from 63rd Avenue East to 63rd Avenue East in a counter-clockwise direction.

Section 2. The Manatee County Traffic Control Division shall erect appropriate "one-way" signs in conspicuous locations within the rights-of-way of all "one-way" roads.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful to operate any motor vehicle (as defined in Section 316.003, Florida Statutes) on any road, street, or highway designated for travel in one direction only by this Ordinance, in any direction other than that so designated.

Section 4. Any person determined to have violated the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have committed a

moving traffic infraction and shall be penalized as provided by Section 316.655, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 318, Florida Statutes.




