AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA RESCINDING ORDINANCE 88-37 DUE TO AN ERROR WHICH INDICATED PARKING WOULD BE PROHIBITED ON 36TH AVENUE WEST; AND AMENDING MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-04, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCES 84-15, AND 84-24 TO PROHIBIT THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON 36TH STREET WEST, A COUNTY MAINTAINED STREET LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Ordinance 88-37 was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on September 20, 1988, and

WHEREAS, due to an error in the advertisement of the legal notice providing that Ordinance 88-37 would prohibit parking of motor vehicles on 36th Avenue West rather than 36th Street West, it is necessary to rescind Ordinance 88-37 , and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316 of the Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida retains jurisdiction over the public streets, highways, roadways and parking areas located within the unincorporated areas of said County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 88-37 in its entirety is hereby rescinded.

Section 2. Ordinance 84-04, Section 1, be amended to add the following no stopping, standing, or parking zone:

36th Street West from 9th Avenue West to 11th Avenue West between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM on School Days

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.


