AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-05; TO PROHIBIT THE TRAVEL OF VEHICLES AT SPEEDS IN EXCESS OF THE ESTABLISHED LIMIT ON PERIDIA BOULEVARD, PRO AM AVENUE EAST, AUGUSTA TERRACE EAST, WEDGE COURT EAST, KILTY COURT EAST, CLUBVIEW COURT EAST, AND PRESIDENTIAL CIRCLE EAST; ALL COUNTY MAINTAINED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316.189(2), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida may set maximum and minimum speed limit in zones after an investigation and determination that such limits are reasonable and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-05, Section 1, be amended to add the following speed limit zones:


- Peridia Boulevard from 53rd Avenue East (SR 70) to the Dead End 20 MPH
- Pro Am Avenue East from 37th Street East to 45th Street East 20 MPH
- Wedge Court East from Pro AM Avenue to the Cul-de-sac 20 MPH
- Kilty Court East from Pro Am Avenue East to the Cul-de-sac 20 MPH
- Clubview Court East from Pro Am Avenue East to Clubview Court East 20 MPH
- Presidential Circle East from Peridia Boulevard to Peridia Boulevard 20 MPH
- Augusta Terrace East from Peridia Boulevard to Pro Am Avenue 20 MPH

Speed Limits

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgement from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.

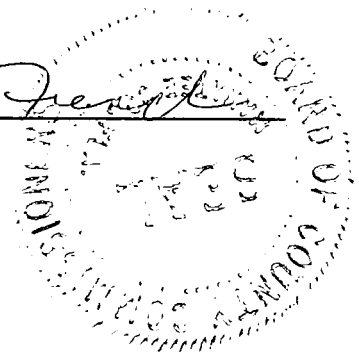
