AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-05; TO PROHIBIT THE TRAVEL OF VEHICLES AT SPEEDS IN EXCESS OF THE ESTABLISHED LIMIT ON SMITH AVENUE FROM BAY DRIVE TO AUBURN AVENUE, AND ON 84TH STREET CIRCLE NORTHWEST FROM 21ST AVENUE NORTHWEST TO 21ST AVENUE NORTHWEST, AND ON 59TH AVENUE DRIVE WEST FROM 2ND STREET WEST TO 12TH STREET WEST, AND ON 47TH AVENUE WEST FROM 26TH STREET WEST TO 30TH STREET WEST, AND IN FRESH MEADOWS SUBDIVISION (PALMETTO), ALL BEING COUNTY MAINTAINED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316.189(2), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida may set maximum and minimum speed limit in zones after an investigation and determination that such limits are reasonable and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-05, Section 1, be amended to add the following speed limit zones:

- Smith Avenue - 20 MPH
from Bay Drive to Auburn Avenue
- 84th Street Circle Northwest - 20 MPH
from 21st Avenue Northwest to 21st Avenue Northwest
- 59th Avenue Drive West - 25 MPH
from 2nd Street West to 12th Street West
- 47th Avenue West - 25 MPH
from 26th Street to 30th Street West
- Fresh Meadows Subdivision (Palmetto):
- 61st Drive East - 20 MPH
from 66th Street Circle East, south to the dead end
- 63rd Ave East - 20 MPH
from Erie Road, south to the dead end
- 65th Court East - 20 MPH
from 61st Drive East to 63rd Avenue East
- 66th Street Circle East - 20 MPH
from 61st Drive East to 61st Drive East


93-20 Speed Limits


