AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-05; TO PROHIBIT THE TRAVEL OF VEHICLES AT SPEEDS IN EXCESS OF THE ESTABLISHED LIMIT ON BAY DRIVE FROM AUBURN AVENUE SOUTHWESTERLY TO THE DEAD END, AND ON ELL WAY FROM PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE TO CONNECTICUT AVENUE, AND ON HERNANDO AVENUE FROM U.S. 41 TO LONGBAY BOULEVARD, AND ON MORGAN JOHNSON ROAD FROM SR 64 TO 44TH AVENUE EAST, AND ON 43RD AVENUE WEST FROM PALMA SOLA ROAD TO 79TH STREET WEST, AND ON 106TH STREET WEST FROM CORTEZ ROAD TO BAYVIEW STREET, AND IN FRESH MEADOWS SUBDIVISION PHASE II (PALMETTO), ALL BEING COUNTY MAINTAINED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 316.189(2), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida may set maximum and minimum speed limit in zones after an investigation and determination that such limits are reasonable and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 84-05, Section 1, be amended to add the following speed limit zones:

- Bay Drive 25 MPH
from Auburn Avenue southwesterly to the dead end
- Ell Way 20 MPH
from Pennsylvania Avenue to Connecticut Avenue
- Hernando Avenue 20 MPH
from U.S. 41 to Longbay Boulevard
- Morgan Johnson Road 40 MPH
from SR 64 to 44th Avenue East
- 43rd Avenue West 25 MPH
Palma Sola Road to 79th Street West
- 106th Street West 20 MPH
Cortez Road to Bayview Street
- Fresh Meadows Subdivision - Phase II (Palmetto)
- 61st Drive East 20 MPH
from 66th Street Circle East, south to dead end
- 62nd Court East 20 MPH
from 61st Drive East, west to dead end
- 62nd Terrace East 20 MPH
from 61st Court East, north to dead end

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of the official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee, Florida, that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
