

ORDINANCE 00-03
(ADVERTISED AS ORDINANCE 99-70)

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 99-27 TO DELETE ESTABLISHED PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON PORTIONS OF THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF COUNTRY PARKWAY; AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-11; REGULATING THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON 1ST STREET EAST, 3RD STREET EAST AND 60TH AVENUE DRIVE EAST; ALL BEING COUNTY MAINTAINED ROADWAYS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; REQUIRING THE ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Manatee county, as a political subdivision of the State of Florida, is empowered, pursuant to Section 316.008, Florida Statutes, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles upon streets and highways within the County's jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 98-11, Section 1.A, be amended in part to delete established parking restrictions on the following rights-of-way:

Country Parkway **From 82nd Way to the dead end**

Section 2. Ordinance 98-11, Section 1.A, be amended to add the following rights-of-way:

AT ANY TIME

1st Street East **From 60th Avenue East to 60th Avenue Drive East**

3rd Street East **From 60th Avenue East to 60th Avenue Drive East**

60th Avenue Drive East **From 1st Street East to 3rd Street East**

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida that the Ordinance has been filed with said office.

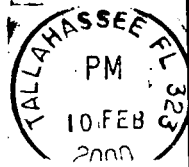

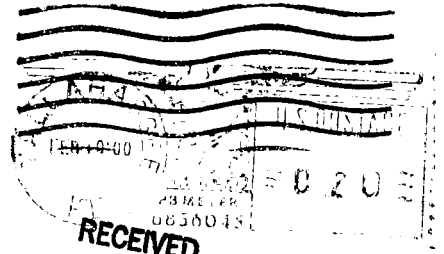
