

ORDINANCE 00-32

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-11; REGULATING THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON 29TH AVENUE WEST; IT BEING A COUNTY MAINTAINED STREET LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; REQUIRING THE ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Manatee County, as a political subdivision of the State of Florida, is empowered, pursuant to Section 316.008, Florida Statutes, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles upon streets and highways within the County's jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 98-11, Section 1.A, be amended to add the following rights-of-way:

AT ANY TIME

29th Avenue West
(north side only)

Adjacent to 2845 21st St. W.

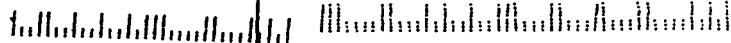
