

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-11; REGULATING THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON 5TH STREET WEST, 9TH STREET EAST, 14TH STREET WEST, 18TH STREET EAST, 19TH STREET EAST (ELLENTON), 33RD STREET EAST, 67TH STREET WEST, 133RD STREET EAST, CARLTON AVENUE, MYAKKA BOULEVARD, 7TH STREET EAST, 36TH AVENUE EAST, 17TH STREET WEST (PALMETTO), 54TH AVENUE WEST, AND 27TH STREET EAST; ALL BEING COUNTY MAINTAINED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; REQUIRING THE ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Manatee County, as a political subdivision of the State of Florida, is empowered, pursuant to Section 316.008, Florida Statutes, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles upon streets and highways within the County's jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 98-11, Section 1.A, be amended to add the following rights-of-way:

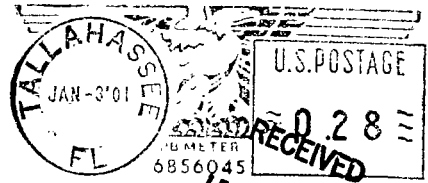

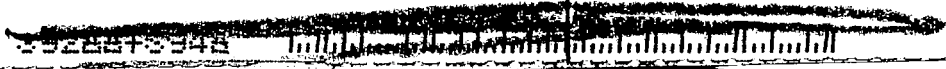
