

ORDINANCE 01-65

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 01-53; TO RESCIND PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON 62ND AVENUE EAST; AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-11; REGULATING THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON 21ST STREET EAST, 24TH STREET EAST, 42ND STREET WEST, 62ND AVENUE EAST AND COUNTRY PARKWAY; ALL BEING COUNTY MAINTAINED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; REQUIRING THE ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Manatee County, as a political subdivision of the State of Florida, is empowered, pursuant to Section 316.008, Florida Statutes, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles upon streets and highways within the County's jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 01-53, Section 1, be amended in part to delete the following right-of-way:

62nd Avenue East from 28th St. E., east 300 feet.
(north side only)

Section 2. Ordinance 98-11, Section 1.A, be amended to add the following rights-of-way:

NO PARKING AT ANYTIME

21st Street East from 58th Ave. E. to 60th Dr. E.
24th Street East from 58th Ave. E. to 60th Dr. E.
42nd Street West from 52nd Ave. W. to 53rd Ave. W.
62nd Avenue East from 28th St. E., east 300 feet.
Country Parkway from 82nd Way E., to the dead end.
(south side only)
