ORDINANCE NO. 09-65

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-3-2 OF CHAPTER 2-3 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY CODE ENTITLED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE RELATED REGULATIONS AND PROVIDING SALE FOR "OPERATORS" OF FOR HOURS OF **ESTABLISHMENTS**; BEVERAGE ALCOHOLIC PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 06-42 was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County on May 23, 2006; and

WHEREAS, that part of Ordinance 06-42 codified at Section 2-3-2 of the Manatee County Code referenced "Hours of sale"; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-3-2 of the Manatee County Code was intended to require establishments dealing in alcoholic beverages to close between 2:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this ordinance to clarify the provision of Section 2-3-2 to prohibit an "operator," as defined by Section 2-3-1(a)(3), of an alcoholic beverage establishment from remaining open between the hours of 2:30 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the amended section is drafted to correct any defects in the section that may detract from its enforceability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Amendment to Code of Laws. The Manatee County Code of Laws is hereby amended to substitute the following as Section 2-3-2 of Chapter 2-3:

Sec. 2-3-2. Hours of sale.

It is unlawful for any operator of an alcoholic beverage establishment in Manatee County to permit said establishment to remain open for business, to permit the public to remain in or upon the premises of said establishment, or to permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages in or upon such premises between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. of any day; provided, however, in the case of restaurants, hotels and motels, such establishments may be kept open for business during such hours but no alcoholic beverages may be sold or consumed during such hours.

SECTION 2: Codification. The amended provision of the Manatee County Code adopted in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be codified as indicated. The codifier shall not codify any other findings or sections of this ordinance not designated for codification.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State in Tallahassee, Florida.
