**AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
AMENDING SEC. 2-22-14 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY  
CODE; REGULATING ENGINE COMPRESSION  
RELEASE BRAKING ON EL CONQUISTADOR  
PARKWAY FROM 34<sup>TH</sup> STREET WEST TO 53<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE  
WEST; REQUIRING ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE  
SIGNS; REQUIRING CODIFICATION; REQUIRING  
COPIES SENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE  
AND THE MANATEE COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR; AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Manatee County, as a political subdivision of the State of Florida, is empowered, pursuant to Sections 316.003 and 316.008, Florida Statutes, to regulate the travel of any class or kind of vehicle on the public roadways within the County's jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida adopted Ordinance 03-52, as amended on September 11, 2003 and codified at 2-22-14 of the Manatee County Code; and prohibiting the use of compression release braking on certain designed roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is desirous to reduce truck noise impacts upon residential neighborhoods; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is desirous of prohibiting the use of engine compression release braking by trucks and other large commercial vehicles on certain additional roadway sections in residential areas within the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 2-22-14(2) of the Code of Laws of Manatee County, Florida (the "Code"), is amended to provide a new subsection (k) as follows:

- (k) El Conquistador Parkway from 34<sup>th</sup> Street West to 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue West.

**Section 2. Codification.** The publisher of the County's Code of Laws, the Municipal Code Corporation, is directed to incorporate the amendment in Section 1 of this Ordinance into the Code.

**Section 3. Copies.** A certified copy of this ordinance shall be furnished to the Department of Revenue and the Manatee County Tax Collector within ten (10) days after adoption.


**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.


