

ORDINANCE NO. 20-39

**AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA,
REGARDING PUBLIC PROPERTY; REPEALING
ORDINANCE 97-29 RELATING TO USE OF CERTAIN
PUBLICLY OWNED PROPERTY BY VENDORS AS A
MARKETPLACE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VIII, Section I of the Florida Constitution, and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida (Board), has all powers of local self-government to perform county and municipal functions and to render services in a manner not inconsistent with general law, and such power may be exercised by the enactment of county ordinances and resolutions; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, the Board adopted Ordinance 97-29, authorizing the use of certain publicly owned property, specifically, a portion of the Bradenton Middle School property, for a market area on Saturdays and Sundays, and providing certain limitations and conditions related to said use; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 97-29 was intended to be temporary in nature and enacted to provide emergency relief to those devastated by a fire which destroyed a facility then known as the Red Barn Flea Market; and

WHEREAS, the former Bradenton Middle School property has long since ceased to serve as a marketplace for vendors affected and displaced by the Red Barn Flea Market fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that repealing Ordinance 97-29 is appropriate and in the best interests of the County and its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The above recitals are correct and true.
2. Ordinance 97-29 is hereby repealed.
3. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.


