

ORDINANCE 23-104

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-22-8 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY CODE; AMENDING THE EXISTING SPEED LIMIT ZONES ON WHITE EAGLE BOULEVARD, AND 33RD STREET EAST FROM STATE ROAD 70 TO WHITFIELD AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 316.189(2), Florida Statutes (F.S.), authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County to set maximum and minimum speed limits on county roads after an investigation determines that such limits are reasonable and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department, has conducted an investigation based on requests from area residents and determined that the changes to speed zones on the county roads identified herein are reasonable and in conformity with the criteria promulgated by the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County finds that the provisions of this Ordinance are in the best interests of the County, its citizens, taxpayers, and business community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County:

Section 1. Section 2-22-8(a)(1) of the Manatee County Code is hereby amended to include the following new and revised speed zones and limits:

Street	Extent	Speed (mph)
White Eagle Boulevard	From State Road 64 to Gatewood Drive	35
White Eagle Boulevard	From Gatewood Drive to State Road 70	40
33 rd Street East	From State Road 70 to Whitfield Avenue	40

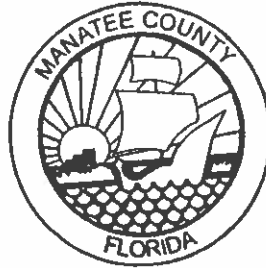
Section 2. Pursuant to Section 125.68(1), F.S., the Codifier shall codify the substantive amendments to the Manatee County Code contained in Section 1 of this Ordinance as provided therein, and shall not codify any other sections not designated for codification.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision or word of this Ordinance is held invalid, same shall be severable and the remainder of this Ordinance

shall not be affected by such invalidity, such that any remainder of the Ordinance shall withstand any severed provision, as the Board of County Commissioners would have adopted the Ordinance and its regulatory scheme even absent the invalid part.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the State of Florida Department of State.
