

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,  
MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, CONCERNING THE EXPENDITURE  
OF PUBLIC FUNDS TO IMPROVE NAVIGATIONAL FACILITIES  
IN ANY CANAL, WATERWAY OR BOAT BASIN

RESOLUTION NO. R-83-3

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Manatee County Board of  
County Commissioners to expend public funds for projects that benefit all  
of the citizens of Manatee County, and

WHEREAS, navigational dredging in canals, waterways and boat basins  
that do not have public boat launching facilities do not benefit all of the  
citizens of Manatee County, and

WHEREAS, it is recognized there may be navigational siltation problems  
in canals, waterways and boat basins without a resultant drainage or flooding  
hazard, and

WHEREAS, it is often difficult if not impossible to determine the cause  
or causes of siltation or navigational blockage in canals, waterways and boat  
basins.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of  
Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. Manatee County will not expend public funds to improve navigation  
in canals, waterways or boat basins unless the expenditure of  
said public funds shall immediately benefit public boat launching  
facilities owned by Manatee County.
