

RESOLUTION NO. R-83-122

RESOLUTION OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA SETTING
POLICIES REGARDING NEW MEMPHIS CEMETERY

WHEREAS, Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, to provide for the health and welfare of the citizens of said County; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-17 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of said County to establish various policies and to promulgate, by resolution, reasonable rules and regulations for the operation of public cemeteries; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Department of Human Services requested that the Board of County Commissioners of said County adopt a policy regulating sales of plots at New Memphis Cemetery, the County Cemetery;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that plots at New Memphis Cemetery not be sold to non-indigent individuals, with the exception that a plot may be sold to a non-indigent individual whose spouse is buried at New Memphis Cemetery, and that such plots shall be sold at a cost of \$150.00 per plot.
