RESOLUTION APPROVING A SUBAREA APPORTIONMENT  
PLAN FOR DISTRIBUTION OF U.M.T.A. SECTION 9  
FUNDS IN THE SARASOTA-BRADENTON URBANIZED AREA

WHEREAS, due to the enactment of the Surface Transportation Act of 1982, the Sarasota-Bradenton Urbanized Area will be allocated annually Urban Mass Transportation Administration (U.M.T.A.) Section 9 formula assistance program funds for transit planning, capital and operating assistance purposes:

WHEREAS, U.M.T.A. requires that an agreement on the subarea apportionment of these funds amongst the designated recipients be approved by the concerned local governmental entities; and,

WHEREAS, the two designated recipients of U.M.T.A. capital and operating assistance funds in the Sarasota-Bradenton Urbanized Area are the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners and the Sarasota County Transportation Authority:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners:

That the U.M.T.A. Section 9 formula assistance program funds apportioned to the Sarasota-Bradenton Urbanized Area be divided equally between the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners and the Sarasota County Transportation Authority, the two designated recipients of such funds.
