WHEREAS, Manatee County Ordinance No. 81-17, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County to establish various policies relating to public cemeteries, and to promulgate, by resolution, reasonable rules and regulations for the operation of the same; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 382, Florida Statutes, requires that prior to the interment or disposition of a body, a burial permit shall be endorsed by the sexton in charge of the cemetery, and further requires that sextons shall register with the local registrar of vital statistics.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida as follows:

1. That the Director of the Manatee County Community Services Department, Human Services Division ("the Director"), is hereby appointed sexton of New Memphis Park Cemetery for the purpose of fulfilling the duties and record keeping required by Section 382.14 Florida Statutes.
2. That the Director is hereby authorized to register as sexton of New Memphis Park Cemetery with the local registrar of vital statistics as required by Section 382.30, Florida Statutes.
3. That the Director is hereby authorized to appoint a designee to fulfill the above described duties in his/her absence.
