

RESOLUTION 90-40

**A RESOLUTION OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA,
PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF 911 FEES
AS IMPOSED UNDER ORDINANCE 86-06, AS AMENDED
BY ORDINANCE 87-33, ORDINANCE 89-36 AND ORDINANCE
90-35, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 365.171. Florida Statutes, Manatee County has adopted Ordinance 86-06 providing for the imposition of a "911" Fee; and

WHEREAS, Section 365.171(13)(a), Florida Statutes, provides for the establishment of a separate audit account for deposit of "911" Fees and an annual determination of whether there exists a deficit or surplus in the account and an appropriate adjustment in the fee on an annual basis, as established by the Division of Communications of the Department of General Services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice from the Department of General Services, pursuant to Section 365.171(13)(a), Florida Statutes, has approved an adjustment in the "911" Fee; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Ordinance 86-06, as amended by Ordinance 90-35, provides that the fees imposed under Ordinance 86-06 may be adjusted by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

1. The fee of fifty (50¢) cents per month per exchange line upon each individual telephone subscriber served by the Manatee County "911" service up to a maximum of twenty-five (25) exchange lines for each such subscriber is hereby adjusted to a fee of ten (10¢) cents per month.

2. This Resolution shall take effect on the effective date of Ordinance 90-35 and fee adjustment provided herein shall apply to all telephone service provided as of April 1, 1990, and continue in effect until otherwise terminated or adjusted.
