WHEREAS, the statutory scheme governing indigent appellate representation was developed and enacted by the Florida Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County

 delegation of Manatee County, to:
 - a. Adequately fund the statutory scheme created by the legislature for legal representation of indigent criminal appellants;
 - b. Appropriate sufficient funds in order to alleviate the Tenth Circuit Public Defender's backlog of delinquent
