

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANATEE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE AN EARNED CREDIT BONUS OF COMPUTERIZED CHEMICAL INJECTOR EQUIPMENT FOR UPGRADING TECHNIQUE FOR APPLICATION OF HERBICIDE ON MANATEE COUNTY RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, chemicals are purchased from annual bid to apply, as permitted by the Department of Natural Resources, to control growth of broadleaf vegetation along road rights-of-way, and

WHEREAS, the vendors offer earned credits in the form dollar value points for gallons purchased, and

WHEREAS, the points offer an opportunity to receive certain technological advancement of either equipment or service that is beyond the funding means of the Aquatic Plant Control budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. The Manatee County Public Works Department has evaluated the offer of computerized injector equipment to be beneficial to the program.

2. The County will make arrangements for installation of equipment on existing vehicle.

3. The County will acknowledge acceptance of this technical equipment from Monsanto Chemical, through Cross Equipment Company of Albany, Georgia.

4. The County will receive this as an asset valued at approximately \$5,000 and utilize the equipment to enhance the herbicide treatment in County rights-of-way.
