**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING THE
EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS/911 CENTER AS THE
"GEORGE B. LUBBEN EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS CENTER"**

WHEREAS, Mr. George Lubben played a vital role in establishing the communications network which exists within Manatee County today; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lubben guided and directed the development of the County's telecommunications functions such that the Telecommunications Division now installs, maintains and repairs all Manatee County radio, telephone and data communication lines; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lubben played a critically important role in the planning, development and installation of the enhanced 911 system in Manatee County; and

WHEREAS, it was through Mr. Lubben's efforts and foresight that Manatee County commenced the installation of the 800 Megahertz multi-site radio system, which system provides the ability for system users, including Departments under the Board of County Commissioners, the Manatee County Sheriff's Department, the Police and Fire Departments of the Cities of Bradenton and Longboat Key, and the Westside and Cedar Hammock Fire Districts to communicate directly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that, in memory of Mr. George Lubben, the Manatee County Emergency Communications/911 Center is hereby designated
