

RESOLUTION NO. R-90-154

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINTING SEVEN (7) MEMBERS TO THE MANATEE COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County Florida, adopted Ordinance 90-01, the Manatee County Land Development Code, on July 25, 1990, with an effective date of October 15, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the said Manatee County Land Development Code, Section 306, established the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board in order to preserve and protect Manatee County's archaeologically, historically, and aesthetically significant sites, districts, and zones; to encourage historical and archaeological preservation; to identify historic buildings and sites and archaeological sites in Manatee County; and to insure appropriate preservation, restoration, renovation, development and adaptive reuse of historical buildings and archaeological sites; and

WHEREAS, the said Manatee County Land Development Code, Section 306, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County to appoint seven (7) members to the Historic Preservation Board, in accordance with the terms of Ordinance 90-01; and

WHEREAS, the initial terms of such Historic Preservation Board members shall be staggered to assure long-term continuity of the Historic Preservation Board and to meet the requirement that no more than two seats shall expire in a single year; subsequent appointment of members shall be for four years; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board, whenever possible, shall be composed of individuals with the following background: architecture, history, planning, archaeology, or historic preservation plus two (2) at-large members;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. Leslie Paugh is hereby appointed to Seat #1 of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board, whose term shall expire on October 14, 1991.

- 2. Lt. Col. W. Johnson is hereby appointed to Seat #2 of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board, whose term shall expire on October 14, 1992.
- 3. Roberta Moore Cole is hereby appointed to Seat #3 of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board, whose term shall expire on October 14, 1992.
- 4. Margaret Moore is hereby appointed to Seat #4 of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board, whose term shall expire on October 14, 1993.
- 5. Linda Stevenson is hereby appointed to Seat #5 of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board, whose term shall expire on October 14, 1993.
- 6. Timothy A. Knowles is hereby appointed to Seat #6 of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board, whose term shall expire on October 14, 1994.
- 7. Allen G. Garner is hereby appointed to Seat #7 of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board, whose term shall expire on October 14, 1994.
- 8. The Historic Commission and the Planning and Zoning Department are hereby encouraged and each invited to appoint one of its staff members to serve as an ex-officio (non-voting) member of the Manatee County Historic Preservation Board.
- 9. This Resolution shall become effective October 15, 1990.
