A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA BEACH EROSION CONTROL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THE RESTORATION OF DUNES AND CONSTRUCTION OF WALKOVERS

WHEREAS, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers has completed a study entitled Beach Erosion Control and Hurricane Protection Study for Manatee County, Florida with Environmental Impact Statement which identifies specific beach erosion problems along the Gulf of Mexico shoreline along the island of Anna Maria; and

WHEREAS, said study recommends a beach renourishment and maintenance project for 22,176 feet of shoreline; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County has committed to sponsoring this project, to be constructed in 1991; and

WHEREAS, Construction of vegetated dunes and walkovers serve to protect and enhance the completed restoration project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1: Manatee County Board of County Commissioners endorses the restoration of dunes and construction of walkovers at public beaches in conjunction with its beach restoration project.

Section 2: That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, Manatee County, Florida, be and is hereby authorized to execute and file an application for funds from the State of Florida under Section 169.091, Florida Statutes, as part of said project.

ADOPTED, in open session with a quorum present and voting, this 11th day of September, 1990. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
