

## RESOLUTION R-90-175

**A RESOLUTION OF MANATEE COUNTY,  
FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING RATES, FEES  
AND CHARGES FOR THE MANDATORY SOLID  
WASTE COLLECTION TO REFLECT AN  
INCREASE IN COLLECTION SERVICE RATES  
AS REQUIRED BY EACH FRANCHISE  
AGREEMENT, WHICH IS BASED ON CHANGES  
IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX.**

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statute 125.01(k) provides the Board of County Commissioners with the power to provide for and to regulate waste collection and disposal; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 1-13 Code of Laws of Manatee County, Florida provides the Board of County Commissioners with the authority to make reasonable rules and regulations found to be necessary for the disposal of all refuse, garbage, and other solid or semi-solid waste; and

**WHEREAS**, Manatee County Board of Commissioners has adopted Ordinance 85-11, providing for mandatory solid waste collection within the unincorporated areas of Manatee County; and

**WHEREAS**, three collection service areas for collection of solid waste were established by the Manatee County Board of Commissioners by Resolution R-85-91, for the purpose of implementing mandatory collection of solid waste prescribed by Ordinance 85-11; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 85-11 provides for the establishment of rates, fees and charges to be paid to Manatee County Public Works Department for receiving such solid waste collection and disposal services; and

**WHEREAS**, the County must establish fees and policies which are just and equitable and which ensure continued funding of necessary programs, facilities and services; and

**WHEREAS,** the Manatee County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolutions R-84-59; R-85-158, R-85-224, R-86-35, R86-254, R-87-189, R-87-318, R-88-06, R-88-195, R-89-182, and R-89-196 which established rates, fees and charges; and

**WHEREAS,** the Manatee County Board of Commissioners executed, on behalf of the County, a franchise agreement with each authorized collector for solid waste; and

**WHEREAS,** Section 3.4.1 of each solid waste franchise agreement requires an annual adjustment of rates when the Consumer Price Index changes; and

**WHEREAS,** the Consumer Price Index for the period of August 1989, to September 1990, increased 6.7% ; and

**WHEREAS,** adjustments to the solid waste disposal fees require an amendment to the Solid Waste Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that:

Resolution R-89-196, which amended Resolution R-88-195, which amended Resolution R-88-06, which amended Resolution R-87-318, which amended Resolution R-87-189, R-86-254, and R-86-35 in part and R-85-158 in part; and Resolution R-89-182 which amended Resolution R-84-59, shall be amended in part as of 12:01 A.M., December 1, 1990. The rates hereinafter set forth shall become effective as of 12:01 A.M. December 1, 1990.

ARTICLE IRATES

1.01 The rates for solid waste collection as approved in the Franchise Agreements by the Board of County Commissioners, are as follows for the three collection service areas:

As stated above, for the three service areas, the minimum monthly charge for residential service shall be effective through October 31, 1991. For commercial service not using refuse bin or roll-off service, the bulk service rate shall be applied.

ARTICLE II

SPECIAL CHARGES

2.01 Special Charges

A. Failure to pay a current bill by the next billing date, may at the discretion of Public Works, result in a 10% penalty on the current past due amount.

ARTICLE III


MISCELLANEOUS

3.01 A license to transport certain occupational solid wastes shall be obtained as provided for in section 31 of Ordinance 85-11. The application fee for a one year license is \$25.00 per vehicle, up to a maximum of \$125.00 (5 vehicles).

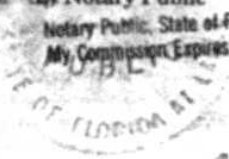
