**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE AMENDMENT OF
STATE CONTRACT NUMBER 88DB-12-08-51-01-N01
PROVIDING FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE ACTIVITIES**

WHEREAS, Manatee County Government has entered into an agreement with the Florida Department of Community Affairs (DCA) bearing State Contract Number 88DB-12-08-51-01-N01; and

WHEREAS, the current expiration date of the contract is December 31, 1990; and

WHEREAS, all of the major construction work has been completed under the contract, but connections to the sanitary sewer collection system and to the water distribution system remain to be accomplished; and

WHEREAS, although diligent efforts have been made to effect the accomplishments scheduled in the contract, unexpected difficulties have caused delays resulting in the need to extend further the time for completion; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners fully understands and appreciates the desirability and need for the timely performance of Community Development Block Grant and other contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That request is hereby made to extend the expiration date of State Contract Number 88DB-12-08-51-01-N01 from December 31, 1990 to April 30, 1991.

2. That as evidence and in reaffirmation of the County's intent, earnest desire and continuing efforts to seasonably perform the terms of the contract, the Chairman is hereby authorized to submit to DCA, along with this resolution, such other documents as may be deemed appropriate and necessary.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

(Regarding Contract Amendment to Rubonia Neighborhood Improvement CDBG Project)

Manatee County intends to request an amendment to the Rubonia Neighborhood Improvement CDBG Project in order to change the time frames for completing the scheduled accomplishments and in order to extend the termination date of the contract.

The request also proposes changes in activities, goals, objectives and budget. The changes involve the following:

- In the Rubonia neighborhood, hook-ups of fixtures (such as sinks, washing machines, etc.) to the sanitary sewer system when it is discovered that these fixtures currently are not connected to a septic tank and, thus, would not be covered under work already planned.
- Since the added work in Rubonia will require funds in addition to those already budgeted for Rubonia, there will have to be a corresponding downward adjustment in funds available for hook-ups to the sewer system in the Washington Park neighborhood. This may result in hook-ups in Washington Park being done on a first come, first-served basis for eligible residents until funds are depleted.

An alternative considered was not to hook up the fixtures in Rubonia to the sanitary sewer system. It has been determined that this alternative was not acceptable.

A public hearing will be held in the Board of County Commissioners Chambers, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Bradenton, on October 2, 1990 at 10 a.m. or as soon thereafter as practicable. The purpose of the public hearing is to consider comments and views expressed by citizens on the proposed amendment prior to its submission to the State of Florida (DCA) for approval. If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County with respect to any matter considered at the hearing, that person will need a record of the proceedings. For such purposes, the person will need to ensure that a verbatim record or the proceedings is made which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
