**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH EXCESS ANNUAL LEAVE BALANCE MAY ACCRUE FOR PAUL G. BANGEL, ASSISTANT COUNTY ATTORNEY, OFFICE OF MANATEE COUNTY ATTORNEY**

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Personnel Policy provides for the maximum accrual of one hundred sixty (160) hours annual leave time for employees of Manatee County with a continuous employment period of five (5) years or less; and

WHEREAS, adjustment for excess annual leave balances occur with the pay period ending December 21, 1990; and

WHEREAS, Assistant County Attorney, Paul G. Bangel, has been employed by Manatee County since September 29, 1988, and is projected to have accrued excess annual leave in the amount of approximately sixty eight (68) hours at the time the adjustments will be made; and

WHEREAS, the present workload of the County Attorney's Office has made it difficult for the scheduling of annual leave time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida:

That Assistant County Attorney, Paul G. Bangel, be permitted to retain all excess annual leave time over the maximum accruable amount until such time as forty (40) consecutive hours annual leave time may be taken and appropriate "pay in lieu of" adjustments made, some time prior to August 31, 1991.
