**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN
EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH EXCESS ANNUAL LEAVE
BALANCE MAY ACCRUE FOR COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR**

WHEREAS, Section 1 (1) of the Manatee County Personnel Policy provides for the maximum accrual of one-hundred sixty (160) hours annual leave time for employees of Manatee County with a continuous employment period of five (5) years or less; ~~and~~

WHEREAS, adjustment for excess annual leave balances occur with the pay period ending December 21, 1990; and

WHEREAS, County Administrator, August V. Ellis has been employed by the Board of County Commissioners for a period in excess of two (2) years and is projected to have accrued excess leave in the amount of forty-six (46) hours at the time the adjustments will be made; and

WHEREAS, the workload of the County Administrator's Office has made it difficult for the scheduling of annual leave time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida:

That County Administrator, August V. Ellis shall have until December 20, 1991 to use the excess annual leave balance accrued prior to the pay period ending December 21, 1990.
