A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY REPEALING AN UNNUMBERED RESOLUTION ADOPTED ON JULY 1, 1963 WHICH DIRECTED THE MANATEE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF HOUSE BILL NO. 2169 OF THE 1963 SESSION OF THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE, AND TRANSFERRING ADMINISTRATION OF THE MANATEE COUNTY WELL CONSTRUCTION PERMITTING PROGRAM FROM THE HRS MANATEE COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH UNIT TO THE MANATEE COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, a Special Act for Manatee County, Chapter 63-1595, Laws of Florida, also known as House Bill No. 2169, regulating the drilling of wells, was passed in the 1963 session of the Florida Legislature; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted on July 1, 1963, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, directed the Director of the Manatee County Health Department to implement the provisions of Chapter 63-1595, Laws of Florida, in Manatee County; and

WHEREAS, the HRS/Manatee County Public Health Unit was formed in 1969 subsequent to the passage of Chapter 69-109, Laws of Florida, creating the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services; and

WHEREAS, the HRS/Manatee County Public Health Unit assumed responsibilities for the regulation of the construction of water wells; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County and the Southwest Florida Water Management District entered into an agreement to allow Manatee County to perform the permitting program for water well construction on August 29, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department/HRS Manatee County Public Health Unit has regulated the construction of water wells within Manatee County until the present time; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 91-388, Laws of Florida, repealed Chapter 63-1595, Laws of Florida, which had located this function in the Health Department; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 91-412, Laws of Florida, created the Environmental Action Commission to administer the County's environmental programs, particularly those protecting the County's air and water quality and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the County Commission held in November 1991, the Board agreed that the Well Construction Permitting Program should be transferred from the HRS/Manatee County Public Health Unit to the Environmental Action Commission of Manatee County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that the Well Construction Permitting Program in Manatee County will henceforth be administered by the Environmental Action Commission.

This Resolution shall become effective upon the Environmental Action Commission of Manatee County accepting responsibility to perform Manatee County's obligations under the August 28, 1990 agreement with the Southwest Florida Water Management District.
