

RESOLUTION R-92-94

A RESOLUTION OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF COUNTY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY TO THE SUNNY LAND COUNCIL OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 125.38, FLORIDA STATUTES

WHEREAS, Chapter 125.38, Florida Statutes, provides that a County may convey personal property owned by the County to the United States, or any department or agency thereof, the state or any political subdivision or agency thereof, or any municipality of this State, or corporation or other organization not for profit which may be organized for the purposes of promoting community interest and welfare at such price, whether nominal or otherwise, as the Board of County Commissioners may fix; and

WHEREAS, the Sunny Land Council of the Boy Scouts of America, registered as a bonafide not for profit organization, has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for the conveyance of certain item(s) of personal property described as a eighteen (18) foot forty-two (42) inch corrugated storm drain pipe to be used to cross a small swale at Camp Flying Eagle to assure year round access; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, is satisfied that the property is not needed for County purposes and is required for the use set forth above and that such use would be in furtherance of the public or community interest and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. Upon receipt of \$ Zero, conveyance of the property to the Sunny Land Council of the Boy Scouts of America is hereby authorized.
2. The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Manatee County, Florida is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete the transfer of the property.
