A RESOLUTION APPROVING A
MARINE PATROL UNIT LAW ENFORCEMENT PROJECT
WITH FUNDING PROVIDED BY
THE WEST COAST INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT
TO MANATEE COUNTY; DESIGNATING
THE COUNTY LIAISON AND PROJECT ADMINISTRATOR; AND
RESCINDING R-92-145

HEREAS, the West Coast Inland Navigation District hereinafter referred to as "WCIND" is empowered and authorized by Section 374.976, Florida Statutes and Rule 16S-2, Florida Administrative Code, to undertake projects intended to alleviate problems associated with its waterway; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 16S-2.004, Florida Administrative Code the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners hereinafter referred to as "County" shall approve each WCIND project application by official resolution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 16S-2.007, Florida Administrative Code, the County shall officially designate a representative who is authorized to act on behalf of the County on all matters related to participation in the program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 374.976(c), Florida Statutes (1991) WCIND is authorized to enter into cooperative agreements with the state and member counties, and to covenant in any such cooperative agreement to pay part of the costs of acquisition, planning, development, construction, reconstruction, extension, improvement, operation, and maintenance of such project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 16S-2.007 Florida Administrative Code, the County is authorized to enter into agreements with the West CC 1st Inland Navigation District to receive funds; and

WHEREAS, the County on June 25, 1992 adopted Resolution 92-145 which established a Boater Safety and Education Program utilizing WCIND funding; and WHEREAS, the Manatee County Sheriff's Office Marine Patrol
Unit has requested WCIND funding for the Boater Safety Education
Project be utilized for a Marine Law Enforcement Project
hereinafter referred to as "Project"; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Sheriff's Office Marine Patrol
Unit has requested Corporal Terry Longpre be designated as
Project Administrator to provide direct supervision and
administration of the Project; and

WHEREAS, such agreements serves a necessary and useful public purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

- The June 25, 1992 Resolution R-92-145 establishing the Boater Safety and Education Project is hereby rescinded in its entirety.
- The County hereby approves Manatee County Sheriff's
 Office Marine Patrol Unit's request for the Marine Law
 Enforcement Project as described in Exhibit A (WCIND)
 Waterway Development Program Application) in the amount
 of \$87,575.00.
- The Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to execute the Agreement between County and WCIND for the \$87,575.00 Project.
- 4. The Director of the Manatee County Community Services Department is designated by County as the liaison agent and is authorized to act on behalf of the County on all administrative matters related to participation in the Project.
- Corporal Terry Longpre, shall be assigned Project
 Administrator for the Manatee County Sheriff's Office
 Marine Patrol Unit to provide direct supervision and
 administration for the Project.

SUBJECT: Justification for WCIND Grant Proposal

FY 93-94

The following information is being forwarded as justification for the FY 93-94 WCIND Grant proposal. The proposal will be addressed item by item.

Training

Self explanatory

Specialized Radio Equipment and Maintenance

We are in the process of upgrading some of our radio electronics. This would include RDF's (Radio Direction Finders) equipment (utilized in the search for vessels in distress and searching for the source of radio signals, when the location is not known). Amateur radios (Ham receivers) utilized as listening stations for overdue ships and vessels along with various other uses. VHF Scanners, utilized for the monitoring of numerous frequencies at the same time. This will give us the capability of scanning different frequency groups at the same time, without locking up our normal radios for that purpose.

4 Wheel Drive Vehicle

This is being request for the second vessel operator. As you know we move our boats in and out of the water and the need for this type vehicle is paramount.

20,000 "Safe Boating" Booklets

This would be the updated "Safety" booklets that we have been giving out to the boaters in this area. They have been very well received and are helping to teach the new boaters some of their responsibilities.

10,625 Safe Boating Bumper Stickers

These are a very good visual reminder to the boaters in the area of their responsibility for safe vessel operation. I have seen numerous of the first print on vehicles throughout Manatee and Sarasota counties.

11,000 Drug Bumper Stickers

These are aimed at the younger people. We are trying to tell them to not become involved with drugs and become a sportsman, which involves boating.

RPIRB's

These are the units that are used when a vessel sinks. When activated, they send a radio transmission to an orbiting satellite and that satellite sends the coordinates to the nearest Coast Guard Station, which enables them to locate the downed vessel and/or people aboard.

Solar Charging Panels

These will be used to keep the batteries on the patrol boats at a full charge at all times. They will recharge batteries after the bilge pumps have been used or should some equipment have been left on by mistake.

Cellular Phones

These will be utilized for contact with unit members no matter where they are. Along with being able to contact law enforcement personnel not on our radio system.

23' Open Fisherman

This is to replace the 12 year old 22' standby boat that we now have. It will be the fastest of the boats and will be able to be used for a third boat during large congregations of vessels, Ie., 4th of July, Offshore Races, Sailboat Regattas, etc.. The interior hull integrity of the 12 year old boat is now past the point of safe law enforcement operational use.

ROBOT SUBMERSIBLE CAMERA SYSTEM

This unit can be utilized to search large areas of water where it would not be advisable for divers to work, due to conditions. It can also be utilized for video taping the various reefs and other county maintained underwater structures as well as underwater surveys of bottom structure.
