

RESOLUTION OF THE MANATEE COUNTY BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINTING FIVE MEMBERS  
TO THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD (CEB).  
MINUTE BOOK NO. 42

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida adopted Ordinance 91-01, The Manatee County Land Development Code, on July 25, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the said Manatee County Land Development Code, Section 305 establishes the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board (CEB) and authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of said County to appoint the members thereof, in accordance with the terms of said Ordinance 90-01; and

WHEREAS, on October 14, 1990 the Board of County Commissioners reconstituted the Code Enforcement Board, in accordance with Ordinance 90-01, and appointed seven members to serve for three year alternating terms; and

WHEREAS, according to Section 305.4.1., the Code Enforcement Board shall, whenever possible, include an architect, a business person, an engineer, a general contractor, a subcontractor, and a realtor; and

WHEREAS, the terms of two board members expired on October 14, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined these two seats are to be filled, and has solicited applications for the positions by press release, posting of public notices, and by contacting the present seat holders and other applicants who may have previously applied for this or other County boards, and having carefully considered all applicants' qualifications and abilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that:

1. Charles A. Decker was appointed to Seat No. 1 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board on September 24, 1992 to fill an unexpired term, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1994.

2. Jerry L. Erwin was appointed to Seat No. 2 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board on September 24, 1992, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1994.

3. J. Michael Faarup was appointed to Seat No. 3 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board on September 24, 1992, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.

4. Robert B. Whitehead is hereby appointed to Seat No. 4 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.

5. Robert L. French is hereby appointed to Seat No. 3 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.

6. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon execution of this document.

RESOLUTION OF THE MANATEE COUNTY BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINTING THREE MEMBERS  
TO THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD (CEB).

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida adopted Ordinance 91-01, The Manatee County Land Development Code, on July 25, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the said Manatee County Land Development Code, Section 305 establishes the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board (CEB) and authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of said County to appoint the members thereof, in accordance with the terms of said Ordinance 90-01; and

WHEREAS, on October 14, 1990 the Board of County Commissioners reconstituted the Code Enforcement Board, in accordance with Ordinance 90-01, and appointed seven members to serve for three year alternating terms; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined these three seats are to be filled, and has solicited applications for the positions by press release, posting of public notices, and by contacting the present seat holders and other applicants who may have previously applied for this or other County boards, and having carefully considered all applicants' qualifications and abilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that:

1. Charles A. Decker is hereby appointed to Seat No. 1 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board to fill an unexpired term, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1994.
2. Jerry L. Erwin is hereby appointed to Seat No. 2 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.
3. J. Michael Faarup is hereby appointed to Seat No. 3 of the Manatee County Code Enforcement Board, and this term shall expire on October 14, 1995.
4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon execution of this document.
